#### Reconfirmation Meeting for **January**

##### **Reconfirm how instruction (Return to Learn Plan) is going to be delivered during the 20/21 school year:**

All K-5 students will attend school every day for face-to-face instruction. Student and staff health and safety will be addressed through a cohort model that keeps students together for the entire school day.

Students in grade 6-12 will begin the year with a hybrid model that allows for more personalized schedules. With this model, all students will attend core academic classes for four class periods per day. Elective courses will be taught remotely for all students in the afternoons. This schedule attends to health and safety by minimizing the number of passing times needed and eliminating the lunch period.

Students may choose to be educated virtually.

By order of the MDHHS, high school students will learn remotely through December 18th. For Montrose Community Schools, this will include grades 8-12.
